




Help Peg crack out of her shell!


You just need an 8.5x11 sheet of paper of cardstock.

5. Fold tab on wing back and glue to paper.




6. Cut egg in half along dotted lines.




2. Color Peg!




3. Color Peg's wings and feet.




7. Apply glue to tabs and glue egg to paper with leg side facing in.




4. Cut out wings and egg along dotted lines.






8. Help Peg crack out of her shell and flap her wings!
